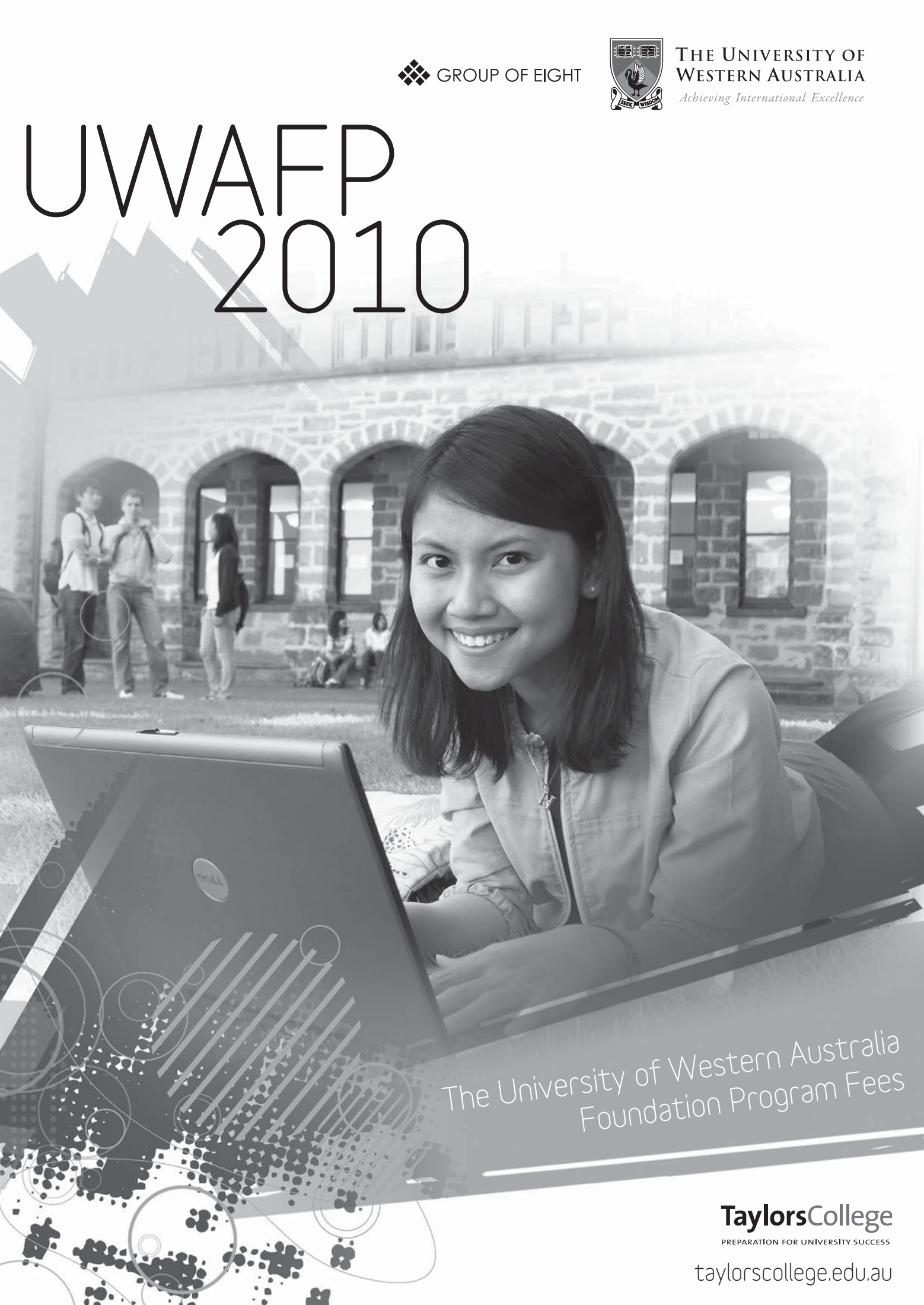

Monthly installment payments dates are available, please contact your campus for details. A fee of \$125 per week is payable to hold a room if a student is absent during the holidays.

<sup>\*</sup> Fees are payable by semester in advance. If a student is absent during the holidays they will be required to pack their belongings and store them with Currie Hall. <sup>\*\*</sup> Currie Hall provides 21 meals per week except during the University's main holiday periods where students will receive breakfast only.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> Taylors College does not have, or subcontract to, shared accommodation. The Accommodation Officer at the campus can provide assistance on how to access rental accommodation.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Students are required to purchase 'Program Length Cover'. The OSHC for the duration of the program will be indicated and payable with the initial tuition fee. Discounts apply for periods greater than twelve months.

All international students are required to maintain OSHC for the entire time whilst holding a valid student visa. Taylors College will arrange OSHC for the duration of your study period upon commencement, with the schools preferred provider.
